


# Additional Recipes - HTML

I wanted to make it easy for the client to add their own cocktail recipes but in order to do that they would have to access the HTML & CSS code for the site, as well as the pop-up window plug-in.


Access HTML code by navigating to "All Pages" in the left vertical menu of the Wordpress dashboard.  
Hover below the "Enjoy" page title and click "Edit"


Once you are in the edit view for the "Enjoy" page, double check that you are in the "Code Editor" view by clicking the three dots in the upper right corner of the page. There will be a checkmark next to "Code Editor", if not, click "Code Editor".

Scroll through the HTML code until you see the code below. I created 5 additional recipe "slots", hiding this code, between these symbols <!-- and -->, until an additional recipe is needed. Copy one of the hidden recipe slots and paste it above the line of code beginning with <!-- then fill in the new recipe information.




# Additional Recipes - CSS

In addition to copying and pasting HTML code, the CSS needs to be edited if any additional cocktail recipes are needed.

Navigate to "Media" located in the vertical left menu on your Wordpress dashboard.  
Select "Library" from the flyout window.  
Either upload your new image in the Media Library, or click on an existing image. Copy the URL from the lower right labeled "Copy Link".



Select "Media" and then "Library"

To access the CSS code, navigate to "Appearance" in the vertical left hand menu and select "Customize". You will be taken to your website edit mode. Scroll to the bottom of the left hand menu and select "Additional CSS".

Click the "Publish" button when finished



Select "Customize" from "Appearance" menu

Scroll to "Additional CSS" to view CSS code. After changes, click the blue "Publish" button at the top of this menu



# Additional Recipes - Pop-Up Recipe Box


Lastly, in addition to copying and pasting the HTML code, and updating the image URL in the CSS code, you need to add the new recipe to the Popup Builder plugin.



Navigate to the Popup Builder menu item located in the left vertical menu on your Wordpress dashboard. Select "All Popups" from the flyout window.

Select "Popup Builder" then "All Popups"

I created 5 additional recipe "slots" in the Popup Builder plug-in. The client would edit the pop-up window and enter the new recipe information, then save the entry.
